Robes Fact Sheet

Robes provides a volunteer led Winter Night Shelter for those in need, providing safety, a warm bed, somewhere to sleep, and a community to connect to. We offer tailored advice, guidance and referrals in all areas, and work in partnership with our guests to aid move on to more long-term accommodation.

Once in their new dwellings, we offer a tenancy sustainment floating support service, aimed at preventing repeat rough sleeping. Both our current and former guests are welcome all year round at our Wednesday Club, where they can receive breakfast, a hot lunch, and showers. Wednesday Club is an opportunity for our guests to reconnect with their community, play some games, have some laughs, and our dedicated advice workers are on hand to assist with any challenges they may be facing.

Robes is a small but mighty charity, and with the assistance of our amazing volunteers, we are proud to support those who need it most.

- £15 will buy a mobile phone top up to ensure a guest can keep in touch with their support network
- £120 will buy a smartphone and credit, so guests can access essential services, apply for jobs, and access benefits
- £24.70 buys a weekly bus pass to help a guest get around the shelters and to essential appointments
- £82.50 will pay for a passport, providing ID which is essential for employment, bank accounts and access to benefits
- £150 will pay for a new home starter pack including essentials such as a kettle, kitchenware & bedding
- £550 will cover a rent deposit for guests needing to access low cost private accommodation



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
